	English: Leather –an animal skin that has been treated to preserve it that is used in making clothes Deer hide – the skin of a deer Smoking - the process of using smoke to flavor or preserve something	Cultural/Ojibwe Moccasins – a flat shoe made out of leather worn by American Indian people Kookum – a Cree word for grandmother
Comprehension	<u>Discussion:</u> Why was Jody not wearing is moccasins outside? How are moccasins different from regular shoes? After making the leather, how do you think Jody’s grandmother made her moccasins? Why do you think Jody’s grandmother put beaded flowers on his moccasins?
